- Participate in collaborative activities (eg. Skype, Google Hangout)
- Complete assignments
- Reflect on personal implementation
- Revise practices based on student feedback and the implementation experience

- Online Learning & Accessibility
- Online Assessment & evaluation
- Policies & Preparation
