

# Moodle Bootcamp

‘Just in time’ training for all Moodle users

Moodle is an online Course Management System with the ability to serve as a teacher webpage as well as function as the online “hub” for resource sharing. Participants in this workshop will learn the basics of setting up a course in Moodle and also explore advanced features available. A hands-on approach will allow educators time to create courses using their own materials. Participants can customize their experience by choosing to attend for 1, 2 or 3 days!
