



Announcing: New and Updated Reports in MI School Data for Preview October 31, 2013

The Center for Educational Performance and Information (CEPI) is pleased to announce the following new and updated reports are available for preview at www.mischooldata.org.

New Reports

- The **College Transfer** report provides a profile of undergraduate students who transferred from a Michigan community college to a 4-year college or university. This report can be found in the left-hand navigation under Postsecondary Summary.
- The **Student Pathways** report provides secure data files containing student enrollment and attainment information on Michigan high school graduates and college students. The data files can be requested for an LEA or any Michigan public college or university by selecting Data Files under Other in the left-hand navigation after logging in as a secure user. *Note:* In order to get this valuable data to you as soon as possible, we are initially providing the file without data in the “Economically Disadvantaged While in High School” field. We expect the report to be populated with data in this field by November 8.

Updated Reports

These following reports have been updated with the most recent data. They are found by clicking Postsecondary Outcomes in the K-12 left navigation menu and under the Postsecondary Summary menu.

- The **College Enrollment** by High School report shows the number of Michigan public high school graduates who enrolled as an undergraduate in a U.S. college or university.*
- The **24 College Credits** report shows how long it is taking for Michigan public high school graduates to accumulate 24 credits in college. *
- The **College Remedial Coursework** report shows the number of Michigan public high school graduates who took at least one remedial course after enrolling at a Michigan college or university.
- The **College Undergraduate Enrollment** provides a profile of undergraduate students enrolled at Michigan colleges and universities.

* The enrollment counts are lower in the College Enrollment by High School and 24 College Credit reports than in previous reported counts. We redefined these reports in order to align with the new Student Pathways report, providing a more accurate reflection of time to enrollment and credit accumulation. We now only count a student once, as of the point they first attend a Michigan college or university (previously the reports counted the student at each college attended).

Secure Access. You must be a MI School Data authorized user to review these reports in preview. If you are a college or university employee and do not already have secure access, [contact your college or university user administrator](#) (Keyholder) to obtain a user name and password for the site and to request “preview” access to the postsecondary reports. If you are a school, district or ISD employee, [contact your ISD Technical Contact or Curriculum Contact](#). The login button is on the upper left-hand corner of the MI School Data home page.
